Tha an taigh agam mòr	<i>hah an tie akam more</i>	My house is big
Tha an taigh agam beag	<i>hah an tie akam bake</i>	My house is small
Am bheil an taigh agad mòr?	<i>am vale an tie akat more</i>	Is your house big?
Am bheil an taigh agad beag?	<i>Am vale an tie akat bake</i>	Is your house small?
Tha còig rumannan ann.	<i>Hah koe-ik roo-manan a-oon</i>	There are 5 rooms.
Shìos an staidhre.	<i>Hee-us an stay-ri</i>	Downstairs
Shuas an staidhre.	<i>Hoo-us an stay-ri</i>	Upstairs
Tri rumannan shìos an staidhre	<i>tree roo-manan hee-us an stay-ri</i>	3 rooms downstairs.
Dà rùm-cadail shuas an staidhre.	<i>dah room-katal hoo-us an stay-ri</i>	2 bedrooms upstairs.
Chan eil e ro mhòr	<i>chan yale eh roh vore</i>	It isn't too big.
'S e taigh ùr snog a th' ann.	<i>Sheh tie oor snok a hah-oon</i>	It is a nice new house
Tha rùm-suidhe, cidsin agus rùm-cadail shìos an staidhre		
<i>Hah room-soo-yi kitchen ah-gus room-katil hee-us an stay-ri</i>		
A sitting room, kitchen and bedroom down the stairs.		
Rùm gu leòr ma tha.	<i>Room goo-lyor ma hah</i>	Plenty of room then.
Tha , rùm gu leòr.	<i>Hah, room goo lyor</i>	Yes plenty of room.

Tha sinn a' dol dhan Ghearmailt    *hah sheen ah doll gan yera-miltch.* We are going to Germany.

Oh glè mhath. Cuin a tha sibh a' dol ann?    *Oh glay vah. Coo-in a hah shiv ah doll a-oon.*  
Oh very good. When are you going there?

Reply

Anns an Lùnasdal. Tha sinn a' dràibheadh ann. An toil leibh dràibheadh?  
In August.    We are driving there.    Do you like driving?

's toil, tha car agam, Ford , a bheil car agad fhèin.  
Yes I like . I have a car , a Ford , do you have a car.

Oh tha , tha dà chàr againn , tha càr beag agamsa , ‘s e Fiat a th’ ann, Fiat beag dearg,  
 Oh yes , we have 2 cars , I have a small car, It is a Fiat, a small red Fiat.

A bhean agam , tha Skoda mòr geal aice. Tha sinn a’ dol dhan Ghearmailt anns an Skoda.  
 My wife , she has a big white Skoda. We are going to Germany in the Skoda.

Cò tha a’ dràibheadh. Who is driving

Tha ise a’ dràibheadh. **She** is driving.  
 Tha esan a’ dràibheadh. **He** is driving.

Tha i a’ dràibheadh an Skoda. She is driving the Skoda.  
 Tha e a’ dràibheadh.am Fiat He is driving the Fiat

Tha e daor a’ dràibheadh càr an-diugh, tha am peatrain daor daor.  
*Hah eh dir ah drive-ag car an-dew, hah am petrol dir dir.*  
 It is dear driving a car today, the petrol is really dear .

Tha peatrain a’ cosg airgead mòr *hah petrol ah cosk erikit more* Petrol costs a lot of money.

Oh tha e glè dhaor. Dè tha e a’ cosg ann an Glaschu?  
 Oh it is very dear. What does it cost in Glasgow?

Not	<i>not</i>	£1
Sgillinn	<i>skee-lin</i>	1p
Fichead sgillean	<i>fee-chit skee-lin</i>	20p
Ach	<i>ach</i>	but or also means (less)

Dè a’ phris a tha e *jay a freesh a hah eh* What price is it.

Tha e not, fichead sgillinn ’s a coig deug.  
 It is £1:35p

Tha e dà not ach sgillinn  
 It is £1:99p

Tha e tri notaichean.	It is £3
Tha e coig notaichean	It is £5
Tha e aon sgillinn deug	It is 11p (the word for pund and penny goes in the middle)
